**City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group will make EVERY EFFORT TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND PLEASANT ENVIRONMENT FOR YOUR CHILD, WE DO REQUIRE THAT THIS PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT BE READ, FILLED OUT, SIGNED, AND DATED BY THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH CHILD UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE WHO WISHES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ACTIVITIES WHICH OCCUR AT CAMP. This form should only be completed if the child wishes to attend Camp. Campers will be placed on a first-come, first-served basis according to availability. This program is limited to participants ages 9 and 15 while attending camp.**

**What is Camp?** Campers will gain valuable life and outdoor skills in or around Lewistown, Illinois. Considering the weather and the heat at times there will be water activities, kayaking, canoeing, swimming, .etc. All water activities will have supervision, and all precautions will be taken for the safety of all. Please understand that the complete and total safety of all campers and staff is of utmost importance to our organization, USA Camp Group. In an effort to maintain a safe environment, if an off-site trip is scheduled, we will hire transportation to transport all campers and staff. We can cancel a trip due to adverse weather, unforeseen circumstances, or any situation that might arise and compromise the safety and well-being of all or any participants. The groups will be under the supervision of trained, qualified, and experienced instructors at a rate of 1 instructor to 10 campers.

I, the undersigned, give permission for my son or daughter to participate in the activities that occur at City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group and other offsite locations that are a part of the camp program. These activities include, but are not limited to, swimming in the pool, boating, ropes course, biking, archery, sports activity, zip lining from trees, and strenuous competition games. I grant this permission with full knowledge that I accept full responsibility for any injury or accident that may occur.

Although City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group has taken reasonable steps to provide equipment and skilled contractors so your child can participate in activities for which he/she may not be skilled in, we now remind you that these activities are not without risk. Certain risks cannot be eliminated due to the Camp's rural setting and without destroying the unique character of those activities. The same elements that contribute to the character of these activities can be cause of loss or damage to your property, accidental injury or illness or, in extreme cases, permanent trauma or death. We do not want to frighten you or reduce your enthusiasm for these activities, but we do think it is important for you to be informed and know in advance about inherent risks.

For promotional or marketing purposes, City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group reserves the right to use any audio, video, and/or photography of guests or campers participating in our facilitated events.

I, on behalf of myself, my children, agree to release and hold harmless City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group its officers, board, agents or employees, for any and all claims for injuries, causes of action, or liability related to my child's participation in any activity occurring at City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group, or other offsite locations. This release does not apply to intentional and/or willful acts of misconduct by City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group or any of its officers, Board, agents or employees.

Should City Kids Camp/USA Camp Group, or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold City Kids Camp & USA Camp Group harmless for all such fees and costs.

*I understand that my child will be in camp from **MONDAY through FRIDAY** on the date I have chosen and in order to participate in camp activities my child has to abide by the Code of Conduct set forth by USA Camp Group. I know my son/daughter will participate in various activities and will be provided with food, camping shelter and I give permission to my child to participate in this program.*

## City Kids Camp & USA Camp Group Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure

### **Purpose and Application:**

We have a ZERO TOLERANCE For bad behavior.

- A. USA Camp Group Code of Conduct is intended to foster a safe environment that is conducive to optimal learning and growth. Toward that end, youth participants are expected to behave in a way that respects the rights and property of others, and that will not disrupt or interfere with USA Camp Group program goals.
- B. This USA Camp Group Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure is a condition of participation in any camp activities or programs.

### **Behaviors Prohibited at USA Camp Group Program Activities:**

- A. Possession, selling, and/or use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and illegal drugs OR being present where individuals are using alcohol, tobacco products and/or any illegal substances
- B. Any kind of sexually related physical contact
- C. Possession of weapons or firearms
- D. Behavior that violates state or local laws
- E. Damage to property of others
- F. Theft, misuse or abuse of public or personal property
- G. Conduct that jeopardizes the safety of self or others
- H. Conduct that disrupts or interferes with the daily activities
- I. Leaving a program or facility without permission of parents or USA Camp Group staff (including authorized volunteers)
- J. Inappropriate dress, including but not limited to clothing that is sexually suggestive, indecent, or otherwise disruptive to the operations or goals of USA Camp Group. Examples include clothing with negative or hateful language or symbols; see-through blouses, skirts or pants; sagging pants; exposed undergarments; bare midriff shirts; and excessively short or tight garments. Clothing should meet the standards expected in public schools. Specific clothing requirements may be required where appropriate for a particular event
- K. Unruly behavior, particularly during overnight events. There should be no unnecessary noise, excessively late hours, or visiting in tents of the opposite sex

### **I. Additional Basis for Disciplinary Action**

We may impose discipline in cases of misconduct by current, former, or prospective USA Camp Group participants if, in the judgment of USA Camp Group personnel or their supervisors, the misconduct poses a potential risk to the USA Camp Group program. This includes risks to the safety or well-being of others and risks to the effective functioning or integrity of USA Camp Group. This applies regardless of whether misconduct occurred during a USA Camp Group activity or in a setting unrelated to USA Camp Group activity.

## **II. Disciplinary Procedures:**

Discipline may be imposed by any USA Camp Group contractors, staff, chaperone, teacher or adult authorized in camp. Who has oversight responsibility for USA Camp Group activities.

- A. Unless immediate action is required, the following procedures must take place before there can be any finding or conclusion of guilt:
  - 1) the accused participant shall be told the charge (which of the prohibited behaviors listed above he or she is accused of violating), and
  - 2) the accused participant is told what factual evidence supports the charge, and
  - 3) the accused participant has been given a chance to tell his/her side of the story.
- C. The USA Camp Group staff must be satisfied that the participants are more likely than not engaged in prohibited behavior before imposing a sanction.
- D. Sanctions may include some or all the following:
  - Verbal warning - Notification to parents - Immediate removal from the activity - Being placed on a behavior contract
  - Referral to local law enforcement and/or juvenile court - Program suspension and/or - Expulsion from program other sanctions appropriate to the circumstances, as determined by USA Camp Group.

### **E. Immediate action situations:**

USA Camp Group or Extension staff may take immediate action to remove a participant from an activity and other action as needed, where there is an emergency or significant risk of continuing misconduct. In those cases, the immediate action is temporary discipline, and the USA Camp Group or Extension staff must arrange for the procedures in parts B, C, D, and E above as soon as possible but in no event longer than a few hours. The parents of the participant will be notified, and the participant will be driven back to their home to with two staff accompanying the hand off.
